Well, 2023 has been an expensive year!

If I'm honest I now realise that the Your Success = Our Success promotion might have been a little foolish. Obviously, we had no idea that Roaring Lion would leave us so prematurely, nor did we foresee just what a superb stallion he would make. How we miss him. His 5 Stakes winners this year added to Zoustar's 4, have been compounded by a late surge from Charm Spirit with his exhilarating Cartier Champion Sprinter, Shaquille. Kameko and Lightning Spear are going to be busy in the covering shed repaying the debts of their comrades' achievements.

But shouldn't it always be this way? Sheikh Fahad's generosity has rewarded those breeders who have found their success at Tweenhills. Normally this would work in our favour with huge books of mares flocking to the stallions in question. Next year we will think of what might have been if Roaring Lion was still looking out at us from his stable across the yard. However, we have the reassurance that the Kitten's Joy blood runs strong through his most precocious and even speedier son, Kameko. We will be wishing away the days to his debut runners.

Whilst we are sad not to have Zoustar with us in 2024, it was long agreed that in his 12th consecutive shuttle season he would be given a well-earned break. Three Northern Hemisphere Stakes-winning two-year-olds this year amongst his 11 Stakes horses sadly isn't enough to push his Tweenhills fee north of the AU\$220,000 he stands for at Widden – so the break has to be at our end. Typically he sired 2 new Gr.1 winners in Australia the week we announced he is staying south next spring. Absence makes the heart grow fonder and he will be back here, refreshed, in 2025.

Kameko will shoulder his flagship burden with aplomb. Never was there an easier horse to work with and his yearlings this year displayed the same qualities that led Andrew Balding to describe him as the "ultimate dude" in training. They have the same 'can do' attitude made famous by Kitten's Joy's offspring but look more muscular and precocious than his predecessor's stock. We just can't wait to see them run in 2024.

As this brochure rolls off the press, our eldest Charlie will be celebrating his 21st birthday. It seems incredible to realise that he is now older than Sheikh Fahad when we first met 14 years ago. Charlie is making his way in the world of agricultural contracting and playing a huge role in that side of the Tweenhills operation; whilst Hubie sits his GCSEs this summer, with Fenella a year behind going from strength to strength at school and on horseback. I've previously made a point of keeping family and business separate, but I am acutely aware that time waits for no one and whilst we wish away the months awaiting first foals, yearlings and runners, the next generation are becoming adults. How important it is that we sow in them the same passion for the land, horses and this sport of Kings and Queens that burdens us.

To this end, Sheikh Fahad and QIPCO have been instrumental in founding Club 26, which has exploded onto the scene this year through the excellent work done by British Champions Series. Over 5,000 youngsters have signed up already and, with huge ambitions to make it the biggest racing club in horse racing, the future of our sport might not look that grim after all. We loved hosting over 70 of them at Tweenhills in November and seeing their wonder at a side of this business they knew so little about.

In the Foreword to last year's brochure, I extolled the virtues of the young here and their drive and ambition. This year I'm shocked to read that Hannah, Graham, Werner, Tydey, Karen, Bryony and Sophie have all been here for at least a decade with others snapping at their heels. Tweenhills is the success it is because of their passion and energy, but it's another reminder that time waits for no man [or woman] – except possibly my mother who has just called to say she's hosting yet another lunch to organise 20 of her friends to sign the Sir Mark Prescott's Affordability Checks petition!

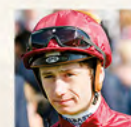

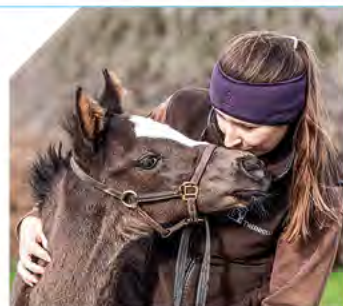
