Kameko, “the ultimate dude” of a racehorse as described by his trainer Andrew Balding, has proven to be somewhat more as a stallion.

In his first season with runners Kameko has proven faster to sire a Gr.1 winner than any of the leading sires in Europe *and* very nearly matched the achievement just a month later when his Gr.2 Royal Lodge winner was placed in unfavoured Doncaster mud in the Gr.1 Futurity Trophy.

The Kitten’s Joy sireline, booming through Oscar Performance stateside and the late Roaring Lion worldwide, has roared again thanks to his record breaking QIPCO 2000 Guineas winner Kameko and aren’t we proud.

That’s just the start of things though as Tweenhills homebreds have been flying the flag for British breeding around the globe. New Century’s Gr.1 Summer Stakes success and Buckaroo’s Gr.1 exploits in Australia for Qatar Racing just touch the surface of what is cooking underneath. David Howden’s marvellous Running Lion’s Gr.2 Duke of Cambridge victory at Royal Ascot was so nearly bettered in the Gr.1 Prix de l’Opera; Cornthrop Bloodstock’s Flight looking every inch a Guineas filly for 2025; and Queen of The Pride – whose parents were both champions bought as yearlings for Qatar Racing – was imperious in the Gr.2 Lancashire Oaks.

This may be a little corner of Gloucestershire in the “middle of nowhere” as Sheikh Fahad once famously described Tweenhills but there’s gold in them hills. Come dig!

It’s not just the land and the manner in which we farm it either. It’s also the care afforded by our wonderful team. I was as delighted for them as I was for Sheikh Fahad when Anthony Stroud and Godolphin paid 1.5m guineas for the Dubawi colt out of Molly Malone and 1m guineas for the Kameko colt out of Potent Embrace, the latter a record breaker at Tattersalls Book 2. Just recognition of a job quietly and ceaselessly done behind the scenes.

We have challenging times ahead with a government hell bent on destroying much that is wonderful about England, family businesses and her rural people. But with ‘Super K’ we have some horse to go to war with. Come ride with us.

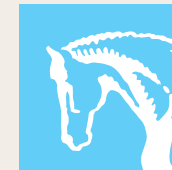

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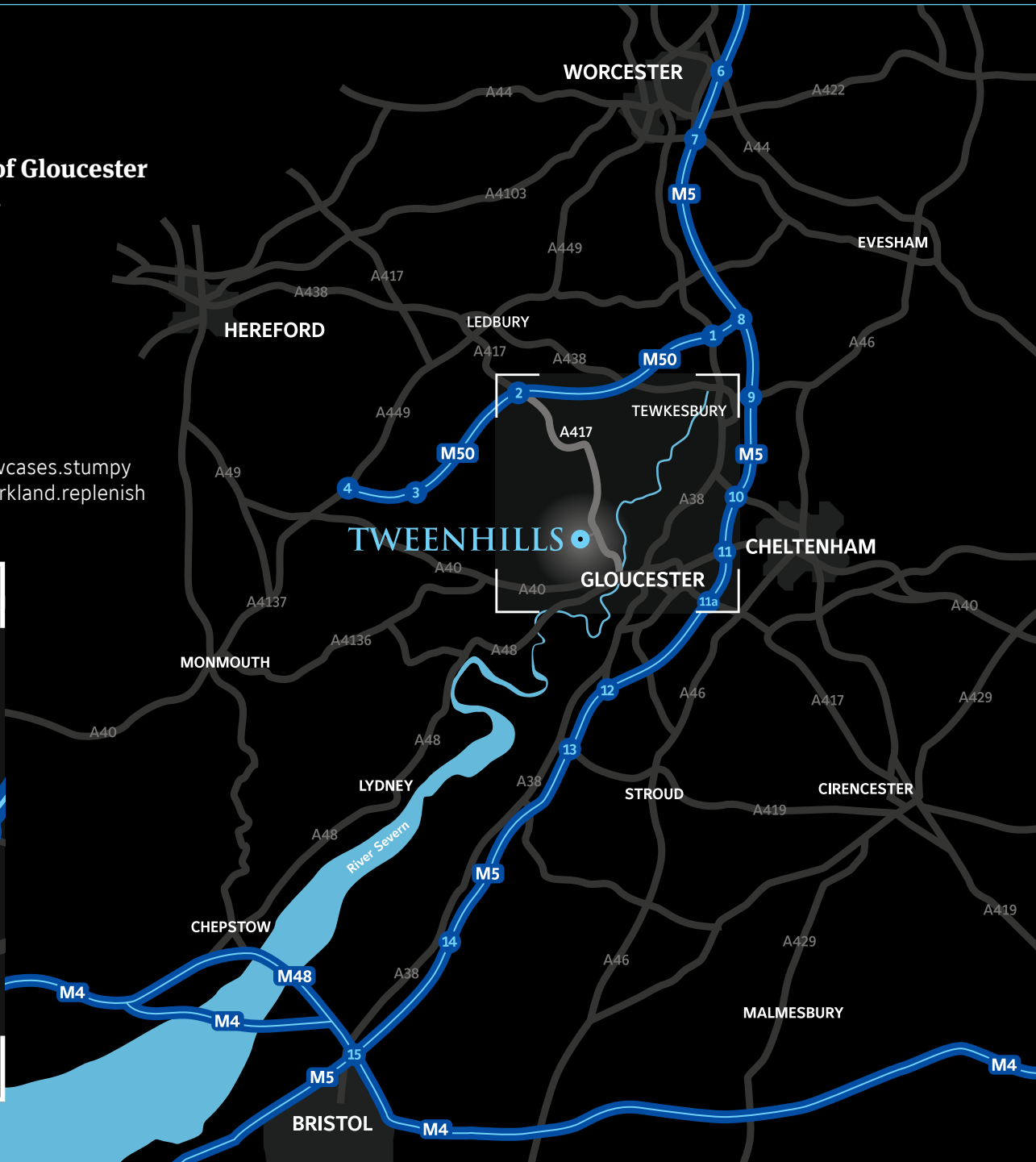
